The Haggis Pairing

GIN – South Loch - Scottish Dry Gin

Botanicals – Juniper, Coriander Seeds, Angelica, Orris, Root Ginger, Green Cardamom, Lemon Peel, Lime Peel, Lemon Juice, Lime Juice, Dehydrated Orange, Kafir, Linden Flower, Purple Heather

1. Pick up and smell your gin neat – The “nose” has fresh lemon and lime, hints of juniper and pine with a fresh and light notes of citrus peels
2. Try your sample neat – You will get the heat of the alcohol but then a fresh light and smooth citrus gin with depth of flavour with aromatics like kafir, heather & linden flower
3. Add 2-3 parts tonic and ice – This will balance with the gin to create a classic dry, citrus led gin and tonic

GIN – South Loch - Spiced Cranberry

Botanicals – Juniper, Coriander Seeds, Angelica, Orris, Root Ginger, Green Cardamom, Pink Peppercorn, Clementine Peel, Clementine Juice, Cranberries, Dehydrated Orange, Pimento, Cinnamon, Elderberries

1. Pick up and smell your gin neat – The “nose” has a complex mix of Indian and Christmas spice with a touch of citrus fruits
2. Try your sample neat – You will get a big hit of warming spice and hints of fruits. This gin is a very complex gin with layers of bold flavours and spices
3. Add 2-3 parts tonic and ice – This reduces the spice but creates a warming and rich gin and tonic

WHISKY – Glenmorangie Original 10yr Old

The Original is the flagship single malt Scotch [whisky](#) from the Glenmorangie Distillery in the Highlands. Matured in a combination of first-and-second-fill American white oak casks for 10 years, the expression is a benchmark for creamy, approachable single malt. A long-running go-to dram for many whisky enthusiasts

1. Pick up and smell your whisky neat – The “nose” is very fruity and thick. Rich notes of lemon, nectarine and apple. Spices.
2. Try your sample neat – Palate: Fresh and balanced, vanilla. Boiled sweets, very creamy, tiramisu, toffee.
3. Finish - Quite long, gentle, malty and very fruity.
