



Self-Guided South Loch Tasting Set no2

3 South Loch Gins | 1 Glass of Ice | 1 Fever-Tree Indian Tonic

GIN 1 – Pink Grapefruit Citrus Gin

Botanicals – Juniper, coriander seeds, angelica, orris, fresh Ginger, green cardamom, lemon peel & juice, pink grapefruit Peels & Juice, dehydrated blood orange, heather flower

- 1. Pick up and smell your gin neat – The “nose” has fresh grapefruit, hints of juniper and pine with a fresh and light notes of summer exotic citrus fruit peels**
- 2. Try your sample neat – You will get the heat of the alcohol but then a very bold grapefruit tang, with aromatics like heather and slight spice from cardamom and ginger**
- 3. Add 2-3 parts tonic and ice – This will balance with the gin to create a classic dry, citrus gin and tonic**

GIN 2 – Rhubarb & Ginger New Tom

Botanicals – Juniper, coriander seeds, angelica, orris, fresh ginger, green cardamom, nutmeg, all spice, orange peel, dehydrated orange, rhubarb, rhubarb leaf

- 1. Pick up and smell your gin neat – The “nose” has a huge hit of fresh rhubarb with a slight rhubarb jam smell and almost a slight floral note**
- 2. Try your sample neat – You will get a big hit of dry heat of the alcohol. This gin is dry it has no added sugars or colour so the rhubarb feels powerful and strong with a slight medicinal property**
- 3. Add 2-3 parts tonic and ice – This will balance with the gin to create a fruit and fresh rhubarb gin and tonic open up the flavours with hints of citrus and floral notes**

GIN 3 – Sicilian Lemon & Ginger

Botanicals – Juniper, coriander seeds, angelica, orris, green Cardamom, lemon peels & juice, ginger juice, dried & fresh root ginger

- 1. Pick up and smell your gin neat – The “nose” has a huge hit of lemon and lemon peels**
- 2. Try your sample neat – You will get a bold hit of lemon oils and lemon peels. The finish carries a warming touch of ginger as a delayed end of the neat gin**
- 3. Add 2-3 parts tonic and ice – This creates a warming and rich gin and tonic with hints of lemon and warming ginger**
